

# Official Notice – Nominations & Elections

## Local Union 765, IBEW

The nominations of officers of Local Union 765 will be held on May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020 beginning at 7pm at the local meeting hall located at the Rodeo Arena Meeting building located at 18118 AL Hwy 99, Athens, AL 35614. Anyone desiring to be nominated must be present during the nominations or provide a written and signed statement that he or she will accept the nomination. No member may be a candidate for more than one office. Anyone nominated to more than one office must choose the office for which he or she will be a candidate.

Nominations will proceed in the order of offices as listed in the IBEW Constitution whose term of office shall be 3 years:

President/Business Manager

Vice President

Recording Secretary

Financial Secretary

Treasurer

Executive Board (6 members)

Delegate(s) to 2021 IBEW International Convention (can run for other offices)

An election judge and teller will be appointed at the close of nominations. None of whom may be a candidate for any office. Number of 2021 Delegate(s) to International Convention determined by the per capita of the local. Executive board and Delegate(s) to the International Convention shall be the candidate(s) that receive the most votes. All other offices shall be decided by the candidate receiving the most votes for that specific office, if a run-off is needed it will be in accordance with the IBEW constitution.

The election shall be conducted by mail ballot, and ballots shall be counted beginning at 5pm on July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020. All members in good standing shall be mailed a ballot not less than fifteen (15) days prior to the above-specified date. Ballots received after the close of business on July 5<sup>th</sup>, 2020, will not be counted.

Each candidate shall be entitled to an observer at the retrieving of and during the counting of the ballots. Observers may not interfere with the orderly procedure of the election. All officers shall be installed and begin their 3-year terms at the regular meeting of the local union 765 on July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020. This notice shall be sent to each member's address that is on file with Local Union 765's financial secretary.
